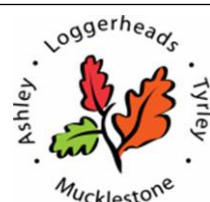

LOGGERHEADS LOOP LAUNCHED

The best way to enjoy our local countryside is on foot, so this summer make the most of the stunning scenery on your doorstep and get walking. The Parish Council, with the help of a grant from Staffordshire County Council and a donation from **The Loggerheads** pub has marked out some walks for you to enjoy. Look out for this new way marker.

The walks are described in leaflets, with maps and easy to follow instructions, available from the Library, Post Office, The Loggerheads and the Doctors Surgery in Ashley, free of charge. Starting and ending at The Loggerheads you can walk 5 or 7 miles on the Western Loop (taking in Mucklestone and Bloor) or 6 miles on the Eastern Loop taking in Ashley. Or start at Hales Club and walk 5 miles to Tryley Wharf on the Shropshire Union Canal and back to Hales via Almington.
