WATCH OUT FOR NOTICES ABOUT THE NEIGHBOURHOOD PLAN – THE DRAFT PLAN WILL BE READY FOR YOUR VIEWS IN OCTOBER



SPEED WATCH has been active over the summer. Over 30 drivers were recorded in an hour driving over 36 mph on A53 in Loggerheads and 24 drivers on B5026 through Knighton. We have recorded speeds of over 90mph on the A53. The busiest road is the A53 but the quieter residential roads witness a higher proportion of speeding drivers. Mucklestone Wood Lane in Loggerheads is the worst, followed by Knighton and Eccleshall

Of the drivers exceeding the speed limit, 30%, that's nearly a third of them, have a TF9 post-code... so they live in the parish! A further 45% are from within 20 miles of Loggerheads and only the final 25% come from farther afield. So, if all those residents who drive at over 30 mph in their own neighbourhood were to reduce their speed, we could make a significant difference to road safety.

PLEASE DRIVE TO THE SPEED LIMIT.
