In recognition of the **long service of ex-Councillor Bert Bennion**, who until May had been a Parish Councillor for the Tyrley ward for nearly 40 years, the Council has named a new public footpath after him; Bennion Way. As a Councillor, Bert first applied to designate the footpath as a public right of way in 1976. The application lay dormant for almost 40 years and just before Bert retired he received the news that the route he had walked for so many years would be preserved for future walkers. The footpath is between Little Heath Green and Clod Hall (off the A53 on the Shropshire border).
