**New Councillor for Loggerheads Ward: Cllr Andy Swetman** has lived in Loggerheads since May 1989. After serving 37 years in the Royal Air Force he took mandatory retirement in 2011. A Helicopter Crewman, Andy spent significant time at RAF Shawbury training new aircrew and as a result, he knows the Defence Helicopter Flying School modus operandi (the helicopters you see flying locally).

He was awarded a Royal Air Force Command, Commander in Chief's Commendation for his work. During his final tour he was Chairman of the Mess for 18 months; the largest mess in the British Military with over 1500 members and he helped to raise over £200,000 for mess improvements.

Since leaving the RAF, Andy was Chairman of the MALT Group that organised the successful Queens Diamond Jubilee celebrations in 2012. For the last 3 years he's been Chairman of Ashley Memorial Hall and has helped to raise funds to renovate the facilities there. During his time as Chairman so far, there has been a significant increase in the hall's usage and the Committee continues to try and widen its appeal. His hobbies include music and walking his dogs.
