VOLUNTEERS NEEDED FOR SPEED WATCH

The local Speed Watch Group has been operating for two years but is now short of volunteers to keep up the level of activity. We are one of the most active groups in Staffordshire. More volunteers are needed; join your active Speed Watch group and make a difference. Contact the Clerk to find out what being a volunteer involves. As little as 2 hours of your time a month would help to reduce speeds and improve road safety in the parish.

Almost 10% of drivers are exceeding the speed limit by *at least* 6 mph and we have recorded speeds of over 90mph on the A53. Of the drivers exceeding the speed limit, 30%, that's nearly a third of them, have a TF9 post-code... so they live in the parish! A further 45% are from within 20 miles of Loggerheads and only the final 25% come from farther afield. So, if all those residents who drive at over 30 mph in their own neighbourhood were to reduce their speed, we could make a significant difference to road safety. **PLEASE DRIVE TO THE SPEED LIMIT.**
