**Inside this Edition: Update on proposals for new housing developments in Loggerheads. What is there for Young People to do – can you help?**

### Proposed Housing on Mucklestone Road, Loggerheads

A developer attended the Parish Council meeting on 27 November to outline initial proposals for 92 new houses on land off Mucklestone Road, behind Price Close in Loggerheads. 15 local residents also attended to hear what the developer was proposing. You may have seen some activity going on in the field during November when they were evaluating a range of issues that would affect a planning application, such as the quality of land, ecology, ground contamination, landscape impact, traffic impact and availability of services such as schools, shops and doctors.

At the end of December, the developer distributed leaflets to residents living adjacent to the site, inviting residents to comment on the proposal and to attend an exhibition held at The Loggerheads pub on 14 January. Did you comment on the proposals? Did you attend the exhibition at the Loggerheads? The next step will be a planning application to Newcastle Borough Council, so be ready to have your say.
