HOW FAST DO YOU DRIVE THROUGH LOGGERHEADS?

The local Speed Watch Group has been operating for over a year. In that time, they have counted over 22,000 drivers of which nearly 2,000 were driving over 36 mph. That means that almost 10% of drivers are exceeding the speed limit by *at least* 6 mph. **More volunteers are needed; join your active Speed Watch group and make a difference.**

Of the drivers exceeding the speed limit, 30%, nearly a third, have a TF9 post-code... so live in the village. A further 45% are from within 20 miles of Loggerheads and only the final 25% come from farther afield. So, if all those residents who drive over 30 mph were to cut their speed through their own village, we could make a significant difference to road safety. **PLEASE DRIVE TO THE SPEED LIMIT.**
